UCL is located in the Bloomsbury neighborhood in the borough of Camden in central London. I am in room 138 in the building generally referred to as “14 Taviton Street” (see photograph below) which is where the **Anthropology Department** as a whole is located. It's at the intersection of Taviton Street and Gordon Square/Endsleigh Place, and has a map kiosk twenty feet outside the entrance and a placard labeled “Anthropology” outside the door.

Note that the department is tucked in between two abutting buildings, each with their own entrance—one occupied by the **Institute of Archaeology** and the other occupied by the **School of Slavonic and Eastern European Studies**—but neither of the receptionists in those buildings will know who you're talking about if you mention my name.

The outer door of the Anthropology Department is always locked, but there's an intercom you can use to buzz the receptionist, who will then let you in (just tell her you're there to meet with me). If you are running late or need to contact me for any reason, give me a ring at the office number above.
